


SUPPLIES

- SHOEBOX
- RUBBER BANDS
 OF DIFFERENT LENGTHS
 AND WIDTHS
- SCOTCH TAPE
- PAINT BRUSHES
- TEMPERA PAINTS
- CARDBOARD TUBE
- PENCIL



DRAW A CIRCLE ON THE INSIDE OF THE BOX AND THEN PAINT IT A NICE COLOR





TAPE THE CARDBOARD TUBE

TO THE SIDE OF THE BOX

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TO DECORATE YOUR GUITAR

DRAW A RECTANGLE AND 6 SMALL CIRCLES

FOR THE HEADSTOCK. THEN TRACE OUT LINES

FOR THE GUITAR CORDS





CHOOSE 2 RUBBER BANDS

OF DIFFERENT LENGTHS BUT THE SAME WIDTH

AND PUT THEM AROUND THE BOX





Now put the other rubber bands


AROUND THE GUITAR

AND PLUCK THEM SO THAT

YOU CAN ORDER THEM BASED UPON

THE SOUND, FROM HIGHEST TO LOWEST PITCH







THE THINNER BANDS VIBRATE FASTER

THAN THE THICKER ONES THEREBY EMITTING A HIGHER NOTE.

THE TIGHTER THE BAND IS STRETCHED, THE FASTER IT VIBRATES.

THEREFORE THE SHORTER BANDS, WHEN STRETCHED,

PRODUCE NOTES HIGHER THAN THOSE OF LONGER BANDS.
